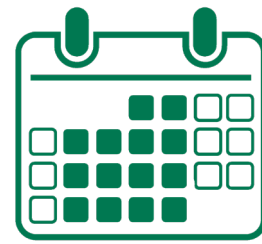

GROUP SIZE 3-10 people

FREQUENCY Offered year-round

Many of our students live at or below the federal poverty line, and while tutors and staff often provide small snacks, food insecurity remains a serious challenge, with SNAP benefits running out quickly.
